Deed of Manumission and Release of Service

Whereas my slave Sewell Bratcher has enlisted in the service of the United States; now in consideration thereof, I, Sarah Walls of Queen Anne's County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment; anamunt, set free, and release the above named Sewell Bratcher from all service due one; his freedom to commence from the 22^d day March 1864 the date of his enlistment as a private in the 3^d Regiment of Colored Troops in service of the United States.

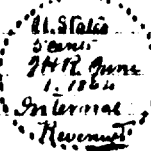
Deed of Manumission and Release of Service

Whereas my slave Arthur Gibb has enlisted in the service of the United States; now in consideration thereof, I, John Denny of Queen Anne's County State of Maryland do hereby in consideration of said enlistment; anamunt, set free, and release the above named Arthur Gibb from all service due one; his freedom to commence from September 1863 the date of his enlistment as a private in the Regiment of Colored Troops in the service of the United States.
