

Shook to Pass Judgment on Other Judges

Montgomery County's new senior Circuit Court Judge Kathryn L. Shook was appointed by Gov. J. Millard Tawes last week to the Maryland Commission on Judicial Disabilities.

The Governor named Judge Shook one of five members of the new body at his last press conference before he leaves office Jan. 25.

The commission, created by a constitutional amendment approved by voters last November, has the power to hold hearings and make recommendations to the General Assembly that judges be removed on grounds of physical or mental disabilities or incompetence.

Judge Shook took over as senior judge when Judge Thomas M. Anderson was sworn in as a judge of Maryland's new Court of Intermediary Appeals.
