Miss Lavinia Engle Quits Maryland League Post

Miss Lavinia Engle has resigned as director of the Maryland League of Women Voters, a position she held during the ten years of the group's existence, according to announcement yesterday by Mrs. Charles E. Ellicott, as president. She paid tribute to Miss Engle's widespread league activities and said the resignation was prompted by the desire to devote more time to research work.

Mrs. Ellicott said that Miss Engle will remain temporarily as her assistant to complete courses of study being given to several members. Miss Engle is a daughter of Mrs. Lavinia Hauke Engle, of Forest Glen, Md., and has made her residence continuous in Montgomery County. She previously was field secretary of the National American Woman Suffrage Association.
