### **Bromwell considers run for county executive job**

FULLERTON — State Sen. Thomas L. Bromwell, D-Baltimore County, says he's "looking at running for county executive" in 1994.

Mr. Bromwell told a crowd of 600 gathered in a Fullerton Knights of Columbus hall for his \$100-a-ticket fund-raiser Tuesday night that he won't decide for sure until fall.

But, pledging solidarity with other Democrats, he said "there will only be one Democratic candidate" to face incumbent Republican Roger B. Hayden in the November election.

Mr. Bromwell, 44, joins an already crowded field of possible Democratic challengers.

They include County Council Chairman Charles A. Dutch Ruppersberger III, D-3rd, Pikesville Councilman Melvin G. Mintz, D-2nd, Catonsville Sen. Nancy L. Murphy, District Judge John C. Coolahan, and former Dundalk delegate and county recreation director Robert Staab.

Even the name of former county executive Theodore G. Venetoulis (1974-1978) has been circulating, although Mr. Venetoulis says his candidacy is unlikely.
