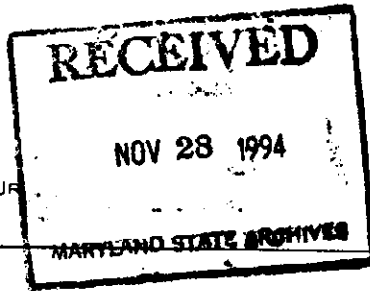

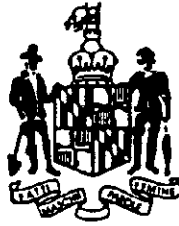

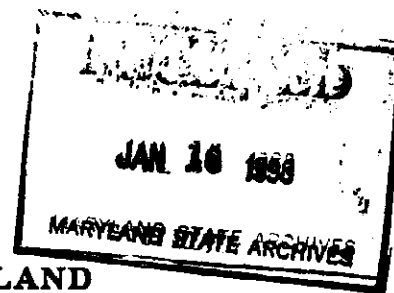

Senator Kelley has been apprised of this appointment and has indicated her willingness to serve in this capacity.

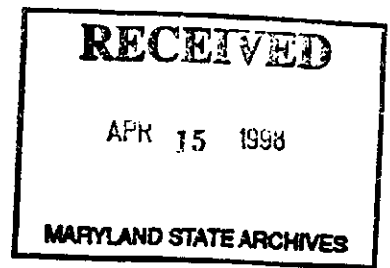
