ANNAPOLIS (August 10, 2010) – Maryland State Treasurer Nancy K. Kopp was elected today as president of the National Association of State Auditors, Comptrollers and Treasurers (NASACT), a 95-year-old Lexington, KY-based organization founded to address government financial management issues.

With a second office in Washington, DC, NASACT offers training and technical assistance programs, handles numerous requests for information from its membership as well as the private sector, monitors federal legislation and agency activities that affect state government and serves as a liaison to federal regulatory bodies and congressional committees.

Treasurer Kopp, who served as first vice president prior to her election as president, said, "For the nearly eight years I have served as Maryland State Treasurer, I have found NASACT to be an immensely valuable organization in helping me gain a perspective on issues important not only to Maryland but the entire nation. The conferences provide a tremendous opportunity to listen and learn."

"I feel honored to lead NASACT," Treasurer Kopp said. "I look forward to working with an outstanding group of state auditors, comptrollers and treasurers."

After serving 27 years in the Maryland House of Delegates, all of them on House Appropriations Committee, Treasurer Kopp assumed her current position in 2002. A member, along with the governor and comptroller, of the Board of Public Works, she also chairs the State Retirement and Pension System.
