

Rembski To Do Grady Portrait

Stanislav Rembski, who has painted the portraits of some of Baltimore's best-known residents, will also do the portrait of Mayor Grady.

Mr. Rembski made some preliminary sketches in the Mayor's office yesterday to get a modern background for the picture. The Mayor said the painting itself will be done in Mr. Rembski's studio. The artist lives at 1404 Park avenue.

Last month, the Board of Estimates authorized \$2,000 for the portrait to maintain the tradition of hanging oil portraits of departed Mayors in City Hall. Mayor Grady leaves his office Thursday for a seat on the Supreme Bench.

He said several persons recommended Mr. Rembski to him.
