## **My negro man Leonard,**

I will give Fifty Dollars. As I purchased him from Major Grahame, I have no doubt that he is in company with his servants.— Leonard is about 22 or 23 years old, his complexion is a glossy black, his teeth of the purest white; he is well made, of rather comely features, and genteel in his appearance. He had a large supply of very excellent clothing, most of which he has removed, and has probably distributed a part to the other boys. As they are travelling in company, they have no doubt their wardrobe in common, and may thus be detected.

Leonard took with him a blue broad cloth coat with yellow gilt buttons, a black bombazet coat, a sky blue cassinet coattee, and one or more striped roundabouts, several fine cotton shirts, a pair of white drilling pantaloons, a pair of black ribbed bombazette or worsted, a pair of white and yellow striped pantaloons of a silken appearance, and probably one or more of nankeen as some of mine are missing; if he has any of mine the name is probably written on some part. Leonard took also with him a black silk vest, several white and yellow marseilles and a parti-colored striped worsted. He may have other clothing, as he was seen on Saturday night with a large bundle, and had access to every part of the house. Leonard has occasionally acted as coachman, but generally as a house servant since I have owned him, and will no doubt solicit employment of that kind.

I remember that Leonard has a large whelk on his neck, apparently the consequence of a severe stroke, which is generally concealed by his cravat.
