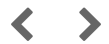

Darrow Glaser, 84, formerly of Hancock and Hagerstown, MD, passed away, Saturday, August 15, 2015, at Menno Haven in Chambersburg, PA.

Born Thursday, November 6, 1930, in Hancock, MD, he was the son of the late Louis Glaser and the late Mary (McFadden) Glaser.

He was a graduate of the University of Maryland and the George Washington Law School. He was a veteran of the Korean War, serving in the U.S. Army from 1950 to 1953. Mr. Glaser was employed as an attorney and also served as a judge with the state of Maryland, retiring after 14 years.

He was a member of the American Legion, B.P.O. Elks Lodge 378, Eagles Club, Tonoloway Rod & Gun Club, Bar Association of Maryland, Alumni Association's of the University of Maryland and George Washington University, and the Lions Club of Hancock. He also served in the Maryland House of Delegates and on the Board of Directors of the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts.

He is survived by his wife, Nita D. Glaser; two daughters, Pamela Munson of Annapolis, MD, and Jacqueline Greenawalt and husband, Harold, of Greencastle, PA; two sons, Larry Munson and wife, Candy, of Selbyville, MD, and D. Twain Glaser and wife, Tana, of Greencastle, PA; sister, Ruth Glaser of Hagerstown, MD; two grandchildren, Colby Zimmerman of Greencastle, PA, and Payton Glaser of Greencastle, PA.

He was preceded in death by two brothers.

Family will receive friends at the Douglas A. Fiery Funeral Home, 1331 Eastern Blvd. North, Hagerstown, MD, on Friday, August 21, 2015, from 4 to 5 p.m., followed by a memorial service at 5 p.m. with the Rev. Robert E. Keener officiating.
