

# *Miss Simpson Named to Rule On Accidents*

Baltimore, Dec. 20.—Gov. O'Connor announced tonight appointment of Miss Vivian V. Simpson, 37, lawyer of Montgomery County, as a member of the State Industrial Accident Commission.

The appointment made Miss Simpson, who now is counsel to the county commissioners and vice president of the County Bar Association, the first woman in Maryland history to achieve a major quasi-judicial post in the State administration.

Miss Simpson, who lives with her mother at 241 Park Avenue, Takoma Park, Md., is a member of the law firm of Simpson & Simpson, of Rockville, Md. The other member is Joseph B. Simpson, jr., her brother.
