

COED REINSTATEMENT FIGHT GOES TO JUDGE

Decision in Suit Against Maryland U. to Be Given Tomorrow.

Miss Vivian Simpson will know tomorrow whether she can reenter the University of Maryland.

Judge Heulsler then will hand down a decision on her suit for a writ of mandamus compelling the university to reinstate her.

Vigorous arguments from attorneys on both sides marked the conclusion of the hearings yesterday in the city court in Baltimore.

C. Morris Harrison, attorney for Miss Simpson, declared her exclusion "an arbitrary, unjust and tyrannical exercise of authority on the part of Dr. Wood, president of the university, absolutely without cause or reason for such action." He referred to his client as a very "unusual person," who had brought "petty jealousies" upon herself because her actions made her stand out when she tried to better alleged conditions at the university.
