

# ANNUAL CONVENTION OF HADASSAH OPENS

**Ten Baltimore Women Among  
Delegates At Atlantic City  
Meeting.**

## NATIONAL HEAD REPORTS

**\$750,000 Raised In Year By Body  
To Care For Palestine Jews,  
Mrs. Lindheim Says.**

Atlantic City, N. J., June 23 (Special).—With 500 delegates already registered and several hundred others expected before midnight the thirteenth annual convention of the Hadassah, the women's Zionist organization of America, was opened here this morning. Among those attending the initial meeting were ten Baltimoreans, who registered at the Ritz-Carlton, the convention headquarters. The sessions are being held in the assembly hall of the Hotel Chelsea, next door.

**\$750,000 Raised In Year.**

The Hadassah is a philanthropic organization which aids Jews in Palestine. During the last year, according to a report made this morning by Mrs. Irma L. Lindheim, national president, more than \$750,000 was raised by the organization. Of this sum, more than \$500,000 was for medical and health work conducted by the organization in Palestine and for new hospital buildings. In addition, the Hadassah sent linens and garments valued at approximately \$60,000 to Palestine for twenty-five institutions.

From a membership of 170 in 1912 the organization has grown to a membership of 34,500 this year, Mrs. Lindheim reported.

The convention was opened by Mrs. Lindheim. After the invocation by Rabbi Harry Davidowics, of the Community Synagogue of this city, Mrs. Samuel Green, president of the Atlantic
