

MURDER MYSTERY APPEARS NO NEARER SOLUTION

Authorities Apparently Have Been Un- able To Gather Any Tangible Evidence.

If the detectives, Sheriff Sullivan, Mayor Strange and others, who have been investigating the Brandon murder mystery of August 8, have gathered any tangible information that might lead to the arrest of the murderer, they are not inclined to let it become known.

Detectives Dougherty, Pohler and Kratz spent all day Sunday in Annapolis in their efforts to clear up certain little details that might have some bearing on the horrible tragedy. In view of the situation as it now exists, no time has been fixed for a meeting of the coroner's inquest which was assembled by Coroner Welch on the night following the tragedy. This body was expected to meet last Wednesday night, but because of the continued activities, the meeting was postponed. It is expected, however, the detectives will close their inquiries within the next few days and then the whole case will be laid before the jury. Widespread feeling and interest in the case still prevails about the city, but the excitement has abated to a marked extent.
