

# NO APPEAL FOR SNOWDEN

**Case Of Condemned Negro Not  
Taken To Supreme Court.**

Washington, Feb. 25.—Although it had been reported here that an effort to save John Snowden, the negro awaiting execution for the murder of Mrs. Lottie May Brandon, made through an appeal to the Supreme Court, this appeal has not been taken. It was said at the chambers of Chief Justice White today.

In their fight for the negro's freedom, his friends made appeals to the members of Congress, but have, as yet, asserted, received little encouragement other than an expression of a will to act if Judge Frank I. Dunbar Towson, should join in an application for clemency.
