BROOKSBY-SHAW HOUSE

Anne Arundel Deeds Liber NH2: folio 20 (1784-87)

5/24/1784

For 510 pounds current money David Long of Queen Anne County, planter, conveyed to John Shaw, cabinetmaker:

"all that....lot of ground....Distinguished on the plat of the said city by the Number 73 and beginning for the part now.... sold....at the distance of 100 feet from the place where a stake formerly stood in Church Street being the end of the first course of the said lot as expressed in Deed of Conveyance of the said lot made by George Johnson to Sowell Long and Mary his wife in August 1751 and being also the beginning of the second course of said lot and the aforesaid beginning of the part now sold being the place from whence a Division fence begins and runs across the said lot to the Stadthouse Circle and running thence the aforesaid secondcourse of said lot bounding on Church Street until it reaches the lot now occupied by Mary Johnson the distance of 105 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet or thereabouts then N 20 degrees East 105 feet to the Stadthouse Circle then by and with said Circle until intersected by a North 20 degrees East Course running with the Division fence aforesaid from the aforesaid beginning of the part now sold."
