

Wednesday, Sept. 29th. The first case called was the case No. 12, criminal appearances; State vs. John Benjamin Biscoe, indicted for the murder of Capt. Robt. R. Dixon. Prisoner brought into Court and arraigned. The Court assigned Messrs. Camalier & Abell and Magruder as counsel. Plea of Not Guilty and application made for removal to another county for trial.

F. N. Holmes Esqr. moved the admission of Richard E. King, colored, as a member of the bar. The Court appointed D. R. Magruder, Robert C. Combs and Enoch B. Abell, Esqrs., a committee to examine Mr. King and report upon his qualifications. The case, No. 10 criminal appearances, was then called and trial proceeded with as follows: State vs. Chapman Green, indicted for assault with intent to kill George Tarlton; plea of Not Guilty and trial by jury. D. C. Hammett for State and Dawkins for defense. Verdict of Guilty and sentenced for two years and nine months to the Penitentiary.

The next case called was No. 7, crim. appearance. State vs. Jno. Harding. Indicted for taking and carrying away bedded oysters. Trial by court. D. C. Hammett and D. R. Magruder for State, pending the trial the court adjourned at 2:30 p. m.
