

Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday at Bethel Methodist Church for George Luther Pendelton, well-known Negro lawyer who had practiced in Baltimore for about forty years and in Annapolis previously. The Rev. J. E. Reese will officiate. Burial will be in Brewer Hill Cemetery, Annapolis.

Mr. Pendelton died Saturday in his home, 1828 Druid Hill avenue. He was born 79 years ago in King and Queen county, Virginia, studied in the Virginia public schools, at Hampton Institute and received his law degree at Howard University.

He was a member of the Monumental Bar Association, of Monumental Lodge, I. B. P. O. Elks, of Hiram Consistory, was a thirty-third degree Mason, and a member of Universal Lodge of Annapolis.

He is survived by his wife, Clarina Harris Pendelton, and by these children: Dr. George Harris Pendelton, Baltimore physician, Clarence McLeane Pendelton, Manzella Pendelton Andrews and Mrs. Merrill Friend, whose husband is serving with the United States Army in North Africa.
