

Sketches Of Council Candidates In Fifth And Sixth Districts

Members of Baltimore's new one-branch City Council will be elected next Tuesday. In the heat of the Mayoralty fight qualifications of the candidates for the city's law-making body have been more or less lost sight of.

Below are printed sketches of the candidates in the Fifth and Sixth districts on the Democratic, Republican and Citizens' tickets. Sketches of candidates from the First and Second districts and the Third and Fourth districts, respectively, were published Tuesday and yesterday.

FIFTH DISTRICT.

Democrats.

JOHN T. FORD, 60 years old, 4101 Bonner road; born in Baltimore; educated in public schools and City College; for many years one of the proprietors of Ford's Opera House; long an active Democrat and interested in municipal affairs; member of the First Branch City Council from the Fifteenth ward for about 20 years, and has been looked upon as one of the advocates in Council of business administration.

GEORGE G. GRIFFIN, 61 years old, 1809 West Lexington street; born in Baltimore; graduate of Calvert Hall College; an architect; interested in politics; member of the House of Delegates in the last session of the Legislature; married; has five children.

CHESTER P. WOODWARD, 43 years old, 2800 Edmondson avenue; born in Baltimore; educated here; graduate in pharmacy and medicine; engaged in the drug business; married; two children; has held no elective office.

Republicans.

WILLIAM N. HILDEBRAND, 62 years old, 112 North Payson street; born in Carroll county; educated in public schools; now in garage business; active in Republican ward politics for many years; member of the City Council in the first Preston administration; member of the House of Delegates in 1918; married; has four children.

WILLIAM P. LAWSON, 42 years old, 4016 Maine avenue; born in Crisfield; educated in public schools, Crisfield High School, St. John's College and University of Maryland Law School; represents an investment banking firm; has held no public office.

OSCAR B. CHENOWETH, 42 years old, 840 North Carey street; born in Baltimore; educated in public schools and high schools; proprietor of an employment agency; active Republican worker in Sixteenth ward for many years; married; has one child.

Citizens'.

EMILIE A. DOETSCH, 14 Merrymount road; born in Baltimore; educated at Western High School and Goucher College; newspaper woman; member of the state and city bar; a director of the Children's Fresh Air Society; has held no public office.

JOSEPH A. RENEHAN, 41 years old, 2157 Chelsea Terrace; born in Cumberland;

educated in the parochial schools; engaged in railroad business; now in the valuation department of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad; always a Democrat; never before sought office; married.

SIDNEY R. GEHLERT, 37 years old, 3615 Morley avenue; born in San Antonio; educated in public schools and city college of that city; engaged in railroad business; for 10 years with Western Maryland Railroad, of which he is now treasurer and assistant secretary; married.

SIXTH DISTRICT.

Democrats.

DR. SAMUEL Y. HARRIS, 55 years old, 100 South Poppleton street; born in Calvert county; druggist; for many years one of the lieutenants of "Frank" Kelly in politics in Southwest Baltimore; Kelly member of the First Branch City Council for two years.

FRANK F. BUSCH, 44 years old, 1283 William street; long active Kelly worker in South Baltimore; has held appointive offices; former member of the House of Delegates; member of the First Branch City Council from the Twenty-fourth ward; married.

JAMES J. O'MEARA, 42 years old, 1503 West Lombard street; born in Baltimore; educated in parochial schools and St. Martin's Academy; active in West Baltimore politics as Kelly lieutenant; property assessor in the Appeal Tax Court.

Republicans.

CHARLES N. BAKER, 38 years old, 1536 Hanover street; born in Baltimore; educated in public schools; in poultry business; married; has three children; has held no elective office.

GEORGE W. WARRENBERGER, 64 years old, 611 West Barre street; born in Baltimore; educated in public schools; employed in the audit department of the Maryland Casualty Company; active in Republican politics; member of the First Branch City Council from the Twenty-second ward.

WILLIAM WEISGERBER, 53 years old, 704 Washington Boulevard; born in Baltimore; educated in public schools; paperhanger; active in Republican politics; member of the First Branch City Council from the Twenty-first ward; married.

HOWARD C. LAMKIN, 36 years old, 1337 West Lombard street; born in Baltimore; educated in public schools and Rock Hill College; wholesale drug business; active lieutenant of Daniel J. Loden in West Baltimore; member of the First Branch City Council from the Nineteenth ward.
