GASSAWAY, Mr. Thomas, died lately at his house near South River.

GASSAWAY, Dr. Thomas J., of Q. A. Co., and Rebecca Hardcastle of Caroline Co. were married Thurs., 22nd ult., by the Rev. James Smith. (Dec. 6, 1827)

GASSAWAY, Dr. Thomas Jefferson, died 15th inst., in his 28th year, at his residence in Q. A. Co. He was a native of Annap.  
(Oct. 29, 1829)

GASTON, the Hon. William, of N. C., and Miss Eliza Ann Worthington, eldest daughter of Dr. Charles Worthington, of George-Town, D. C., were married Tues., 3rd inst. (Sept. 12, 1816)

GEDDES, Capt. David, died on Friday [March 6], at Balto., an old inhabitant of Fell's Point. (March 12, 1807)

GEDDES, David R., died on Tues. [July 23], in Annap. (July 25, 1816)

GEORGE, Mr. Joshua, died on Sat. last, in Caecil [sic] County, for many years a Representative of that county [in the Maryland Assembly], and a prosecutor in that and in two other counties.  
(Nov. 9, 1748)

GEORGE II, King of Great Britain, died on October 25, 1760, in the 77th year of his age, and in the 34th year of his reign.  
(Jan. 1, 1761)

GETTY, Robert, of George-Town, and Miss Margaret Wilmot, of Annap., were married Tues. evening last [Dec. 27], by the Rev. Mr. Judd. (Dec. 29, 1808)

GHISELIN, Reverdy, Clerk of the Provincial Court, died Sun., 2nd inst. (April 6, 1775)
