

## MURDERED ON THE ROAD.

Three Men in Jail on Suspicion of Killing Lloyd Vermillion.

UPPER MARLBORO, Md., Sept. 2.—The body of Lloyd Vermillion was found in the road here this morning. Benjamin Lawson, Asa Tucker and John E. Lawson, with whom he left town last night, were placed under arrest. Before the Coroner's jury John E. Lawson testified Tucker struck Vermillion and threw him off the wagon. He was afterwards thrown into a ditch. The dead man was 25 years of age, and leaves a wife and three children.

His brother, Joe Vermillion, was lynched for burning barns. The accused are locked in jail here. Benjamin Lawson has been behind the bars before charged with killing an old negro, Sam Hedges, with a club.
