

## Hard to Find a Grave.

ELLICOTT CITY, Md., May 29.—Relatives of Henson, the condemned murderer, who was dragged from the Howard county jail and lynched at an early hour Tuesday morning, declined to take the body from the jail, where it had awaited a claimant, saying they would have nothing to do with it. Undertaker Stephen Hillsinger was instructed by Sheriff Flower to go ahead with the burying at the county's expense, but Mr. Hillsinger was not able to get permission for the interment in any land about Ellicott City, and the sheriff found himself compelled to bury the corpse on his own farm, eight or ten miles distant. The tree upon which Henson was hanged has been cut to pieces by relic-hunters.
