LYNCHING AT UPPER MARLBORO, MD .-Mike Green, colored, who committed an assault on Miss Alice Sweeny, of Prince George's county, on the 26th ult., and was lodged in jail therefor at Upper Marlboro', was lynched on Sunday evening, about a mile from the town. Green's crime was of an aggrieved character, and intense excitement prevailed at Marlboro' from the moment of his arrival there. Threats of lynching were freely made, and but for the vigilance of the sheriff,the jail where he was confined would have been broken into last week. On Sunday night, however, a band of masked men succeeded in forcing the jail, and secured their prisoner. Green is said to have struggled desperately while the noose was being ajusted about his neck, and tohave made a full confession, after which the rope was thrown across one of the boughs of a tree and the victim jerked fifteen feet from the ground. Early travellers along the road the next morning saw the lifeless body still dangling fromthe limb.
