

TO INSTALL DR. FELL TODAY

Will Be Part Of University Of Maryland Commencement Exercises.

Dr. Thomas Fell will be formally installed as provost of the University of Maryland at the commencement exercises to be held at the Lyric this afternoon.

Judge Henry Stockbridge, who has served as provost since the death of Bernard Carter, will make the announcement of Dr. Fell's election, and will also preside at the exercises. Governor Goldsborough will address the graduating classes and Philemon H. Tuck, president of the Alumni Association of St. John's College, will deliver the congratulatory address.

Miss B. Olive Cole will be awarded the gold medal in the department of pharmacy, and J. M. Buch Portuondo, of Cuba, leads the class in medicine, which numbers 49. There will be 61 doctors of dental surgery and 39 bachelors of law. A. I. Strenge will receive the gold medal from the department of dentistry.

St. John's College, which is the department of arts and sciences of the university, will present 18 bachelors of arts and six bachelors of sciences to be awarded diplomas.

The alumni association of the department of medicine will hold its annual banquet at Hotel Emerson tonight.
