May 28th thereof, he paying the purchase money
 and Complying with all other requisites
 according to Law may obtain a grant thereon
 (which purchase money is to be paid
 within one year from the date hereof
 Lay out therefore and Carefully resurvey for and
 in the name of him the said William White the afore-
 said land according to its ancient Metes and bounds
 &c.

28th Whereas Joseph White of Allegany County
 did set forth that there was Excheat to the
 State Lot A^o 1525 lying in the County
 aforesaid for want of the heirs of John
 Delanaway who did seized thereof and
 intestate by means whereof the same
 hath become Excheat to the State as it is ap-
 prehended and he the said Joseph White
 being desirous to secure the same, be it
 Excheat as aforesaid or by any other way
 or means whatsoever, required a special
 warrant to resurvey and affect it and
 that on return of a Certificate of Resurvey
 he paying the purchase money and
 Complying with all other requisites
 according to Law may obtain a grant
 thereon
