

*Sentenced to be Hung.*—The military commission, recently in session in this city, of which Lieut. Col. H. D. Munson, of the 159th Ohio, was president, and Major Este, judge advocate, found true bills against the following named persons: Wm. H. Rogers, rebel spy, blockade runner and rebel mail carrier; John B. H. Embert, Braxton Lyon and Samuel B. Herne, rebel spies, rebel soldiers and blockade-runners. The commission sentenced them all to be hung between the hours of 6 and 8 o'clock, on the morning of the 29th of August. The sentence has yet to be approved by the President. In the meantime the doomed men are confined in Fort McHenry, where the commission has stated the execution must take place, if the findings are approved by the President.
