Bids Mayor Remove Gibson, Griffin From School Board

A group of taxpayers unhappy over the actions of the city School Board during the past year is sending a letter to Mayor D'Alesandro asking that two board members be removed.

John J. Iago, a member of the group, described the board as "hopelessly deadlocked" and charged that some School Board members are attempting to drive out Dr. Thomas D. Sheldon, the city school superintendent.

The board members the group hopes to see removed are James M. Griffin, whose term expires next year, and Larry S. Gibson, whose term expires in 1974.

List Of Names

Michael J. Davis, vice president of the Alexander Hamilton Republican Club and a spokesman for the group, said a list of names of persons whom the group considers qualified to fill the seats on the board will be sent to the Mayor.
