DRIVEWAY PROPOSED TO ENCIRCLE THE CITY

Reclamation of Anacostia Flats Is Another Project. * E. H. Tucker President.

A wide program of improvements for the northeastern section of the city is planned by the Northeast Washington Citizens association, under the direction of Evan H. Tucker, president of the organization. For this purpose committees have been formed.

Among the most important plans being forwarded by the association are reclamation of Anacostia flats and indorsement of the so-called "park improvement," which embraces a driveway to encircle the city extending through Rock Creek park, for a distance of more than 10 miles.
