Sales Tax Fought In Prince Georges

Exchange Club Against Levy in Any Form.

Opposition to any form of a sales tax in Maryland was expressed at the recent meeting of the Prince Georges County Exchange Club at the Beaver Dam Country Club.

A committee was appointed to confer with the county delegation in the legislature on the problem of taxation, consisting of Dr. W. Burton Spire, chairman; Ralph W. Powers, Walter L. Green and Robert W. McCullough.

Uniform numbering of houses on the Washington-Baltimore boulevard was advocated by the club and a committee of five was appointed to study the project. Charles P. Burton is chairman of the group.
