

McCullough Named County Trial Justice

Robert W. McCullough, 52, of 4614 Addison Chapel rd., Beaver Heights, Md., has been appointed by Governor W. Preston Lane to

be a trial justice of Prince Georges County.

McCullough, an attorney, will replace Justice Arthur P. Owens, who is retiring August 31. The new appointee will serve for a four-year term.

A graduate of

Havre de Grace (Md.) High School in 1916, McCullough received a degree from the dental school of George Washington University in 1919, then practiced dentistry in Washington while studying law at National University Law School.

He received his law degree in 1929, practiced law beginning in 1930. He is a member of the D. C., Maryland, and American Bar Associations.

A Democrat, he was campaign manager for Senator Millard Tydings (D., Md.), in 1938. McCullough is married and has three sons.
