To Gen. SAMUEL SMITH.

WE offer you our sincere congratulations on your re-election to the important station of representative in congress for this district—a station which, from a consideration of your past services, and well known attachment to the just principles of equal and rational freedom, we have no doubt but that you will fill with honor to yourself and advantage to your country.

Believing that your conduct as a legislator has ever been, and will continue to be both useful and upright, with extreme pain have we witnessed the attempts which have been lately made, to fully it with the imputation of unworthy principles and motives, and an opinion attempted to be propagated, that the supporters of your late election consisted, chiefly, of the meaner classes of society, the enemies of administration and the friends of French influence and outrage.
