JAMES H. BRADY

Funeral services for James H. Brady, retired oyster and fruit packer, who died yesterday morning after a short illness at his home, 4610 Roland avenue, will be held tomorrow morning.

A native of Ireland, Mr. Brady came to Baltimore when he was about 20, after living for some time in Ohio. He entered the packing business here and retired about 1904. He was a member of the University Club and the Knights of Columbus. Mr. Brady was 85 years old.

He is survived by four sons, James H. Brady, Jr., George M. Brady, I. France Brady and Dr. Leo Brady, and two daughters, Mrs. Joseph Parker Norris and Miss Katherine T. Brady. His wife, Mrs. Kate T. Hunter Brady, died several years ago. There are thirteen grandchildren.

Requiem high mass will be celebrated at St. Ignatius' Church at 9.30 A. M. tomorrow.

Funeral services for Charles M. Armstrong, who died yesterday at the Maple Shade Nursing Home, Front Royal, Va., will be held at 4 P. M. today in that city.

Burial will be in Greenmount Cemetery here at 12.30 P. M. tomorrow, with the Rev. N. B. Harmon officiating.

A native of Virginia, Mr. Armstrong spent a large portion of his life practicing law in Baltimore. He also was active in church affairs here. He married Miss Harriet C. Sisson, this city, who died in 1920.
