DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This long stone masonry house in 2 parts is 2 1/2 stories, 5 bays by 2 plus 3 by 2 in the wing, facing south. The roof ridge-line of each part runs east-west. Windows in the main house have 9 lights on 6 downstairs, 6 over 6 elsewhere.

About 1930 a four-columned portico was added to the south doorway with a sun porch accessible from a third story window. A double-deck porch is added to the east end, and a three-sectioned double deck porch, mostly enclosed, is on the north.

Original floors are covered with narrow width flooring. 2 of the 7 fireplaces are closed.

A fine staircase rises to the third floor in easy stages, 2 flights to a storey, the simple light bannister open at the center.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

"Westwood" was the name used by Dr. Skipwith Coale and his wife Elizabeth, for whom the house was built by her father, Chief Justice Samuel Chase at the end of the 18th century. It remained in the Coale family until about 1928. One of the few buildings in Harford associated with an historic figure. Samuel Chase was also a signer of the Declaration of Independence.

Partitions were opened, steel beams added, and many changes disregarded what must have been a fine old house. Still very imposing, it needs much repair. For sale in March 1971. The smaller-scale west wing was added by William Coale in 1920.

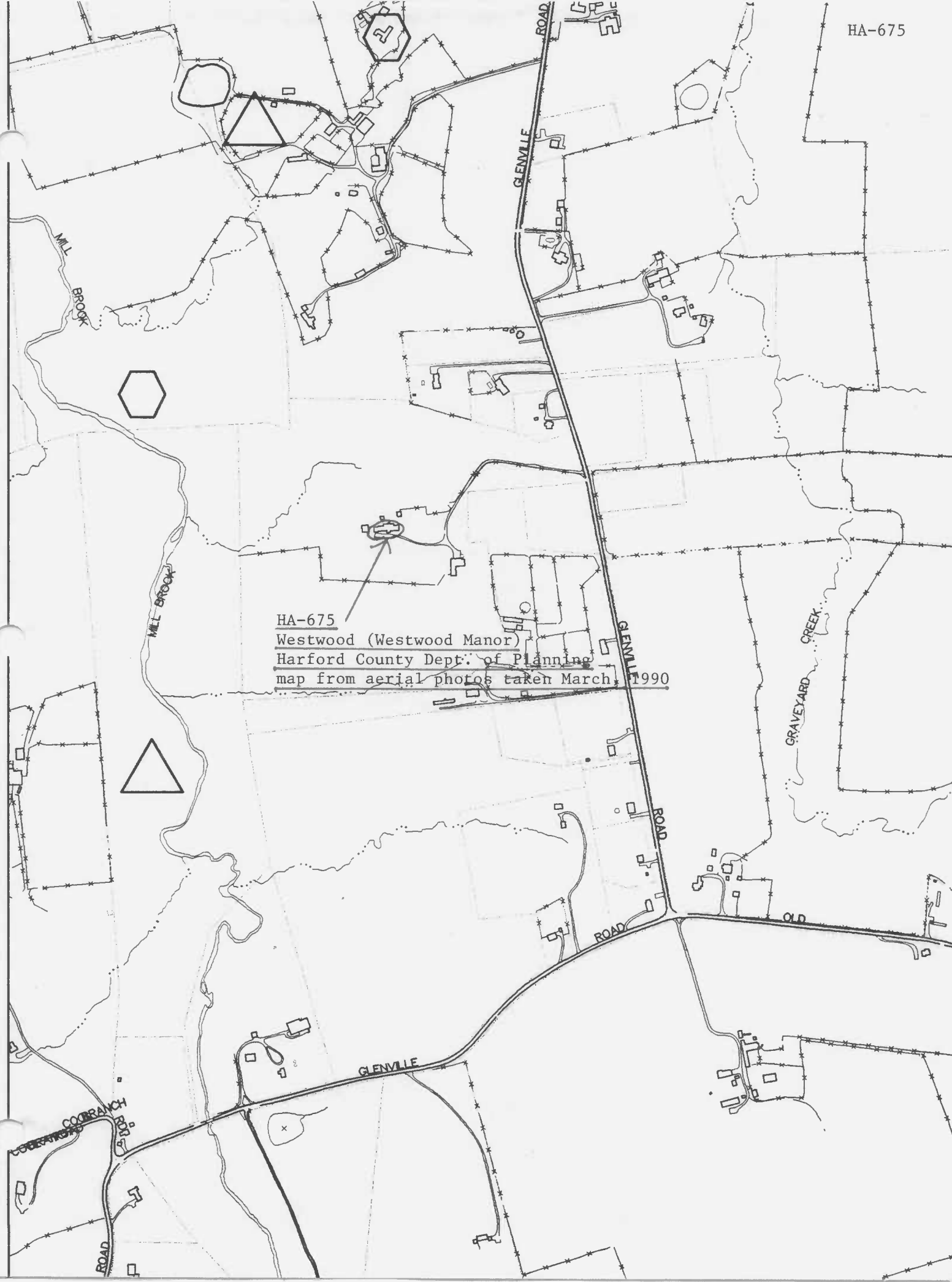
