

Be it remembered that I Skipwith H. Coates of
Hurdorf County in the State of Maryland Physician
being in the full possession of all my mental faculties
do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
that is to say It is my will that all my just debts and
General expenses be fully paid and satisfied as early after
my decease as may be convenient - Item Having
manumitted all the Slaves that belonged to me except-
ing Lucy it is my will that the said Lucy shall be free
and manumitted as soon as the debt due for the pur-
chase money paid for her shall be liquidated, whether
by her personal services or by the balance being paid
on her account - Item I give and bequeath to my
dear wife Eliza Coale all the rest residue and re-
mainder of my estate real personal and mixed of what-
soever sort and kind and wheresoever found for her
entire and exclusive disposal of it to the equal benefit of
each of my children, provided that in the division of my
estate the right of election shall be given to each of himself
and herself in the rank of seniority as to the particular
portion of my estate that shall devolve to himself or herself
and provided that the portions to be inherited by my children
shall become theirs at the decease of their mother My said
wife Eliza Coale or at whatever period previously she may choose
Item I hereby constitute and appoint my dear wife Eliza Coale
the sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament, and
I nominate her also the exclusive Guardian of my children -
Item I do hereby fully and unequivocally renounce and
revoke every other will and Testament either written or verbal
heretofore

heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last
and only true Will and Testament - Signed, executed
pronounced and published the ninth - day of
December in the year One thousand eight hundred and
twenty nine 1829 =

Joseph Daves two of the subscribing witnesses to the within foregoing last will and testament of Mipwith H. Coale late of Hayford County deceased, and severally made oath on the Holy evangel, of Almighty God, that they heard the testator herein named acknowledge this instrument of writing to be his last will and testament, and that he was at the time of his so saying, to the best of their apprehensions of sound and disposing mind memory and understanding and that they severally subscribed their names as witnesses to this will in the presence and at the request of the testator and in the presence of each other, but not in the presence of James Coale the other subscribing witness.

paid. I Will and bequeath as follows:

Item. I give and bequeath unto Samuel
Miskimon ^{of Harford County} for valuable services to me ren-
dered. The lot of ground whereon I now live
together with all my other property, Real
personal or mixed. Whom I also appoint
executor of this my last Will and Testam-
ent
