& education amongst us the people called Quakers but having so far departed
from the established order of our society as to be joined in marriage to a
"woman not in membership with us by the assistance of an heathen Leader
"we deny him, the said Sam^l Robertson any farther right of membership
"amongst us until he becomes sensible of his said disorderly conduct & condems
in the same to the satisfaction of this meeting. -
