A certificate for Sam^l Lukens was produced agreeable to the direction of last Meeting which was read, concurred & approved the Clerk is directed to transcribe, & sign it on behalf of the Meeting & furnish Samuel therewith.

A certificate was produced for Sarah Richardson, which was read approved & signed by the Clerk on behalf of the Meeting & directed to be recorded & forwarded.

Mary Brooke & Caleb Bentley have returned the Copies of minutes furnished them in the 3rd month last & informed they have performed their visit agreeable to their prospectus.

A Certificate of Removal was rec^d from the Mo. Meeting of Philadelphia held the 28th of the 5th mo. last for John Payne Todd in his minority which was read & accepted.

Tho^s Shrieve & Ann Hopkins appeared in this Meeting & declared their intentions of marriage with each other the first time his being a member of another Mo. Meeting is desired to produce to our next Mo. Meeting a certificate therefrom respecting his clearance from marriage engagements with others as also his Mother's consent.

The time of holding of our next Mo. Meeting in course coming in the week in which the Yearly Meeting is expected to be held it is therefore concluded to adjourn to the 5th 6th day in next month at the usual place.

At Indian Spring Mo. Meeting held at Sandy Spring (by adjournment) the 23rd of the 10^{mo}. 1801, the representatives being present.

Ans^r 1st — all our Meetings for worship & Discipline (except the efforts from which we have no account at this time) are attended by a considerable part of our members; though some remain too remiss in this necessary duty at the hour nearly observed; unbecoming behaviour mostly avoided.

Ans^r 2nd — Love and unity appear to be maintained in a good degree as recommended; Falshood, backbiting & spreading evil reports mostly discouraged, & care taken to remove apparent difficulties.

Ans^r 3rd — offenders are dealt with nearly as recommended.

The following named friends are appointed to attend the Quarterly Meeting with our report, viz, Sam^l Hopkins, Joseph Cowman, Sam^l Swinson, Gedra Brooke, Thomas Moore & Caleb Bentley.

The Committee on Meetings lands is continued, friends of that appointment not yet being ready to report.

The friends appointed in the case of Mary Denny are continued under the appointment.

Joseph Cowman on behalf of the Committee appointed to take an opportunity with George Chandler, agreeable to the direction of last Meeting reported, that part of their number attended thereto, and that George did not seem disposed to comply with the decision of a former Mo. Meeting in his case, but expressed a wish that friends would bear with him a little longer which being considered, his request is granted, & his case vested under the care of the same committee.
