THE Condition of this Obligation is such, That
if the above bounden *John Woodside*

of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of *Major Archibald Anderson*
deceased, do make, or cause to be made, a true and perfect Inventory of all and
singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said deceased, which have or
shall come to the hands, Possession or Knowledge of him the said

or unto the Hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for him and
the same so made do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the Register's Office,
in the County of Chester, at or before the *eighteenth* Day of *March*
next ensuing; and the same Goods, Chattels and Credits and all other the Goods,
Chattels and Credits of the said deceased, at the Time of his Death, which
at any Time after shall come to the Hands or Possession of the said

or into the hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for him do well
and truly administer according to Law. And further, do make, or cause to be
made, a true and just Account of his said Administration, at or before the
eighteenth Day of *Decem. next* And all the Rest and Residue of the said
Goods, Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Ad-
ministrators Account (the same being first examined and allowed of by the Or-
phans Court of the County of Chester) shall deliver and pay unto such Person
or Persons respectively as the said Orphans Court by their Decree or Sentence,

gister's Office) then this Obligation to be void and of none effect, or else to
remain in full Force and Virtue.
