

FREDERICKSBURG, June 13

On Saturday last an unhappy rencounter took place in this town between Mr. Thomson of Port-Royal, and Mr. Reveley of Baltimore, which had nearly terminated the existence of the latter gentleman. Mr. Reveley conceiving himself injured by some publications and assertions of Mr. Thomson, and meeting him at a store in this town, called him out, and began horse-whipping of him; upon which Mr. Thomson drew a pistol which he had in his pocket, and bid him desist, at the same time threatening to discharge the pistol at him if he persisted, but Mr. Reveley not regarding him, he lodged the contents of the pistol in his breast. The wound was at first thought mortal, but we are since informed, ( though the ball is not yet extracted ) that that gentleman is in a hopeful way of recovery. Mr. Thomson was immediately taken into custody.
