The latter gentleman had the first fire, and wounded his antagonist in the elbow of the right arm, so severely that he was unable to return it. We are unhappy to add, that since the termination of this unfortunate affair, Mr. Thomson has had his arm taken off, and is thought to be in a dangerous situation.
