

# Prince Georges Gives Ritchie Winning Lead

## Bowie Runs Well Ahead of McCullough for State's Attorney.

A few early and scattered returns from the Maryland primaries in Prince Georges County showed Gov. Ritchie leading Dr. Conley with a substantial majority. In the fight for the county offices, State's Attorney Alan Bowie, running for reelection, was distancing his opponent, Robert W. McCullough.

In the majority of precincts election officers had just begun to count votes. No Republican votes had been counted.

Both in Hyattsville and Mount Rainier, considered by the followers of McCullough as their stronghold, Bowie was already declared victor. Piscataway and several lower county precincts were also going for him.
