

**WHEREABOUTS OF WM. L. CHAPLIN.**—This famous abolitionist, who forfeited his bail in the sum of \$19,000, in Maryland lately, has gone to Ohio, and on "the Reserve," it is said, intends to hold a series of anti-slavery meetings, with the object of presenting his case to the people, and of receiving contributions for the relief of his bondsmen. The Syracuse Journal says that several of his personal friends devoted their entire means in his behalf, and by the forfeiture of his bail, are left penniless, and it adds that it is to indemnify them that series of "Chaplin Meetings" have been held in New York State and Massachusetts, and that like meetings are to be held in Ohio, and perhaps some of the neighboring States.
