An act to alter change and repeal such parts of the Constitution and form of Government of this state as relate to the division of Saint mary's county into electional Districts.

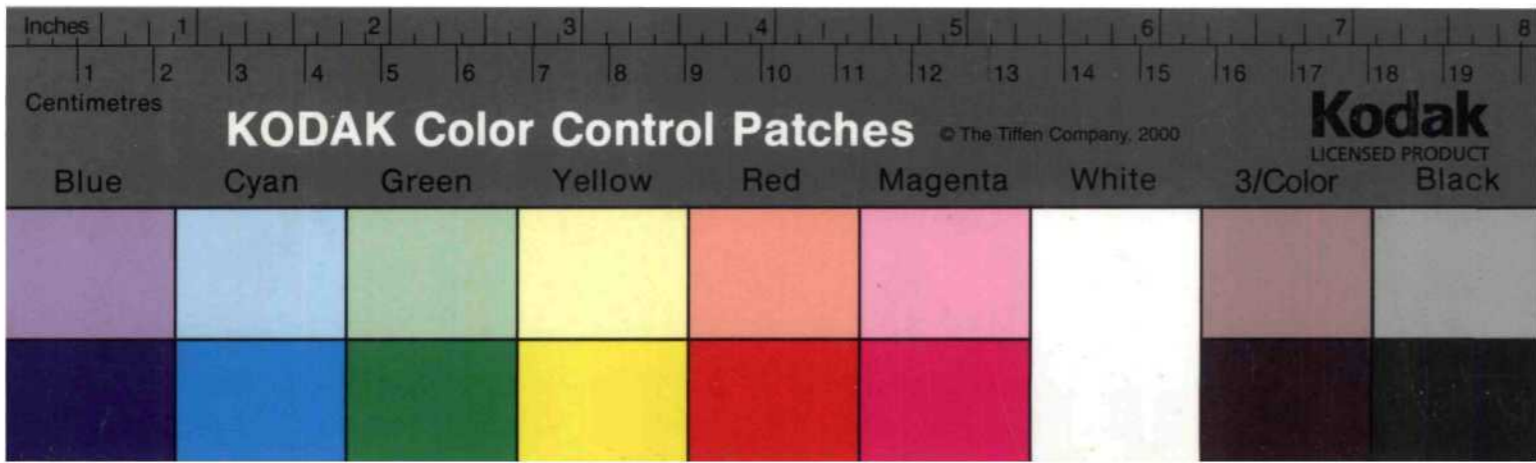
Whereas it is represented to this General Assembly by the petition of sundry Inhabitants of Saint Mary's county that they experience great inconvenience for the want of a fourth District in the said County and praying an alteration in the first and third Districts so as to establish and admit of a fourth between them, and the prayer of the petitioners appearing reasonable,

Be it Enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland that all that part of the constitution and form of Government, made such by the acts of <sup>seventeen hundred and ninety eight and</sup> seventeen hundred and ninety nine which directs that Saint mary's county shall be divided and laid off into three separate Districts be and the same is hereby repealed.

And be it enacted That Saint mary's county shall be divided into four separate Districts and that the <sup>additional</sup> District shall be laid off adjoining and between the first and third districts as

are now numbered.

And be it <sup>Enacted</sup> that if this act shall be confirmed by the  
general assembly of Maryland after the next election of Delegates  
in the first session after such new election as the constitution and  
form of government directs in such case this act and the alteration  
herein contained shall constitute and be considered as a part of  
the said constitution and form of government to all intents and  
purposes any thing therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding

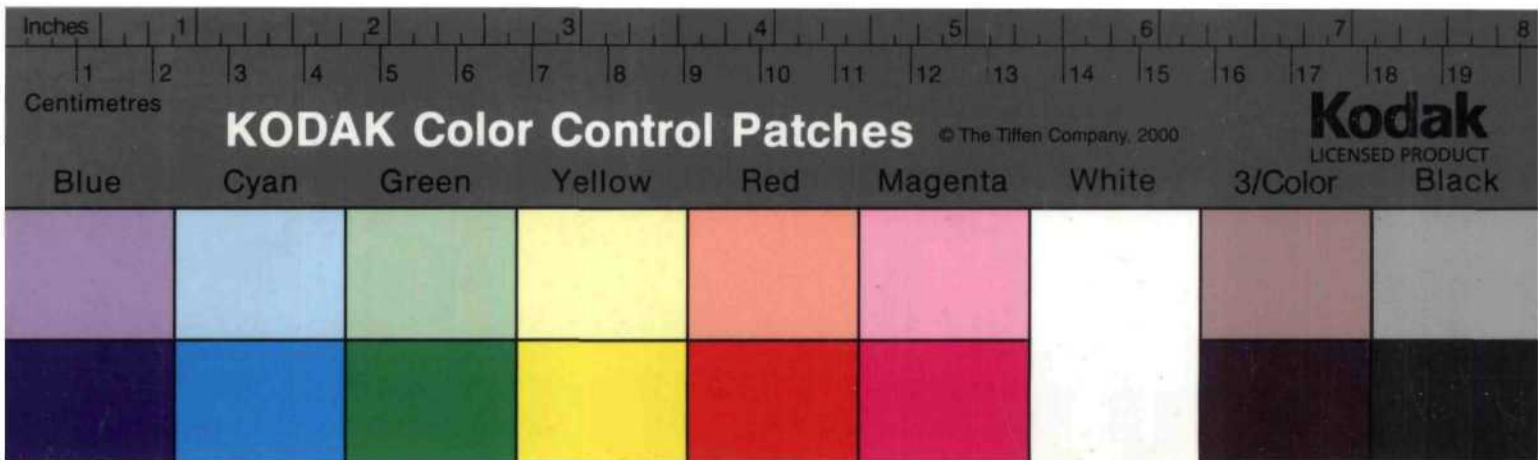
