

An act to alter change and repeal all such parts of the Constitution and form of government of this state as relate to the division of Prince Georges County into Election Districts

Whereas it is represented to this General assembly by the Petition of sundry inhabitants of Prince Georges County that they experience great inconvenience for want of a sixth Election District in said County and praying an alteration in the second, third, and fifth districts so as to admit a sixth district between, and the prayer of the petitioners appearing reasonable Therefore

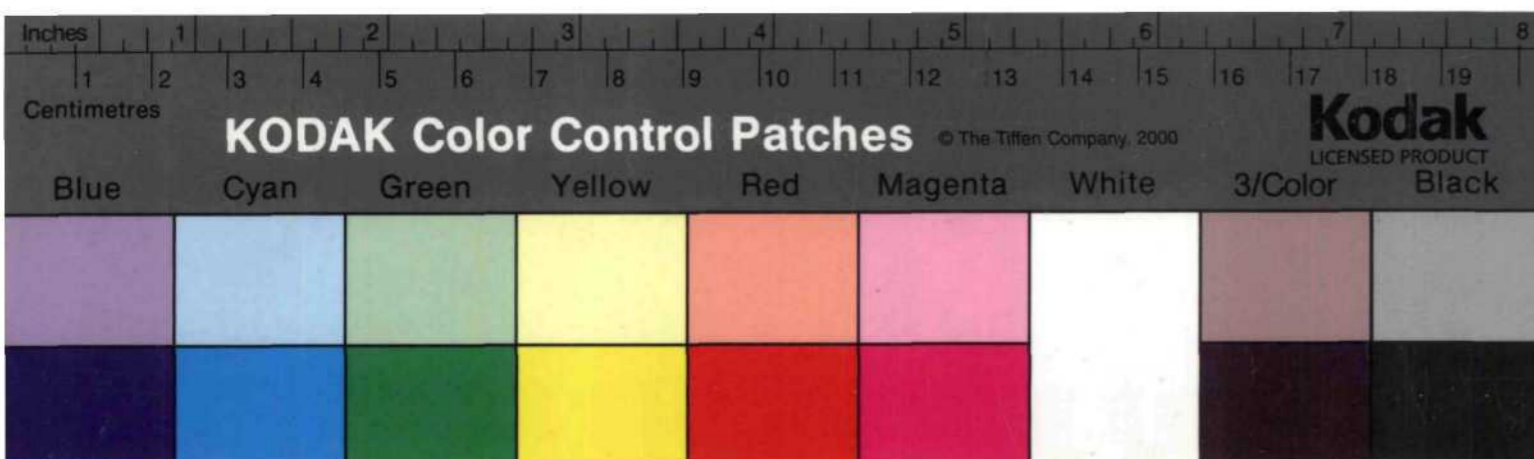
1 Be it Enacted by the General assembly of Maryland that all that part of the Constitution, and form of government, made such by the act of seven-
teen hundred and ninety eight which directs that Prince

Georges County shall be divided and laid off into five separate Districts be, and the same is hereby repealed

2 And Be it Enacted that Prince Georges County shall be divided into six separate districts and that the ~~sixth~~ additional district shall be laid off adjoining and between the second third and fifth districts

3 And Be it Enacted that if this act shall be confirmed by the General assembly of Maryland after the next election of delegates in the first session after such new Election as the constitution and form of government directs in such case, this act and the alterations herein contained shall constitute

and be considered a part of said Constitution and form of government to all intents and purposes, any thing therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding
