CHAPTER NO. 320.

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT to propose an amendment to repeal Article 38 of the Declaration of Rights of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, said Article requiring the General Assembly to give its consent to gifts or sales of land to churches and to all gifts made by will to churches and denominations.

- 1 Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-
- 2 land, (three-fifths of all the members of each of the two Houses
- 3 concurring), That Article 38 of the Declaration of Rights of
- 4 the Constitution of the State of Maryland, requiring the con-
- 5 sent of the General Assembly to certain gifts to churches
- 6 and denominations, be and it is hereby repealed if adopted by
- 7 the legally qualified voters of the State, as herein provided.
- 1 Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That the aforegoing
- 2 amendment to the Declaration of Rights of the Constitution
- 3 of the State of Maryland shall, at the election to be had in
- 4 November, 1944, be submitted to the legal and qualified voters
- 5 of the State for their adoption or rejection, in pursuance of
- 6 the directions contained in Article 14 of the Constitution of
- 7 the State of Maryland, and at the said general election the vote
- 8 on the said proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be by
- 9 ballot, and upon each ballot there shall be printed the words:
- 10 "Amendment to repeal Article 38 of the Declaration of Rights
- 11 of the Constitution which requires the General Assembly to

- 12 consent to conveyances and certain gifts to churches and de-
- 13 nominations" and underneath thereof the words: "For Consti-
- 14 tutional Amendment" and "Against Constitutional Amend-
- 15 ment", as now provided by law, and immediately after said
- 16 election due returns shall be made to the Governor of the vote
- 17 for and against proposed amendment, as directed by said
- 18 Fourteenth Article of the Constitution, and further proceed-
- 19 ings had in accordance with said Article 14.
