The new flag of Ghana symbolizes a new age coming into being... colored man has a new sense of dignity and self respect... college grads face responsibilities because they live in this new era... must learn to live together as brothers or die together as foals...

New job opportunities open... be ready to enter when the doors open... be ready to compete with people... not colored people... but people... if you go out to be a good colored anything, you have already flunked your examination for entrance in the University of Integration... If you're a street sweeper, sweep streets well...

Enter this new age with understanding goodwill in your heart... work passionately and unrelentingly for first-class citizenship... we must never use second-class methods to gain freedom... meet hate with love, physical force with soul force... love men not because we like them, not because their evil ways appeal to us, but because God loves them... the universe is on the side of the forces of justice, truth and righteousness.

We can walk down in Montgomery, Ala., and never get weary because we know there is a great camp meeting in the promised land of freedom and justice... go out determined to make the ideals of brotherhood a reality for your generation and for your children and your children's children... with this attitude and this work we will be able to create a new America and sing with new vim... 'My Country 'Tis of Thee'...

Speaking extemporaneously and without a single note, the Rev. Martin Luther King, electrified the 290 Morgan State college graduates and the 3,000 visitors who turned out to hear him deliver the college's annual commencement address, Monday evening.

The Rev. Mr. King, famed Montgomery, Ala. boycott leader and pastor of Dexter Ave. Baptist Church there, received an honorary doctor of laws degree from the college after his 10-minute talk.

The exercises were held in the Hughes Memorial Stadium.

IN HIS talk, the Rev. Mr. King told the graduates: 'You have the privilege of standing between two worlds, the dying old and the merging new. This is a great time to be alive.'

He traced the history of the present fight for freedom in America and abroad, admonishing the grads 'you have opportunities that did not come to your mothers and fathers.

'Doors are opening today that were not open yesterday. The challenge of this hour is to be ready to enter these doors'... go out to do a good job...

THE COMPLETE text of his

and left standing in the piercing chill of an Alpine November.

These people became tired, and they decided to protest against that oppression.

And as a result of that, about 1 billion three hundred million of the 1 billion 6 hundred million forms of colonial subjects have achieved their independence. As they look back, they see the old order of colonialism passing away — the new order of freedom and justice coming into being.

I remember about a year ago seeing something of this first hand, and then to what was then the Gold Coast to the independence celebration.

I never will forget the experience that came to all of us on that night, that the old nation was to pass away and a new nation to come into being. I remember as we stood out there where hundreds and thousands of people assembled, waiting for the old flag to go down and the new flag to go up.

I remember that moment when the union type flag came down, you could hear echoing all across that vast crowd of people — the words — FREEDOM, FREEDOM, FREE DOM!

AS THOSE words came out, tears began to pour from my eyes. On my right was standing Dr. Ralph Bunch, and on my left was standing my wife and Congressman Adam Clayton Powell.

And as I looked around to them, I could also see tears pouring forth.

must go; that separate facilities are inherently unequal; That the segregated child on the basis of his race, is to deny that child equal protection of the law.

As a result of this decision, we see the whole order of segregation passing away and the new order coming into being.

To put it in difficult language: We broke loose from the Egypt of slavery — we move through the wilderness of separate but equal, now we stand on the border of the promised land of integration — the old order of segregation is passing away, and the new order of democratic equalitarianism is coming into being.

LET NOBODY fool you. All the loud noises that we hear today in terms of interposition and nullification are merely the death groans from a dying system — the old order is passing away.

But now that a new world is coming into being of a new order, we must not stop here for when new developments take place in history, they bring with them new responsibilities, and new challenges.

It would be tragic, indeed, if you would go out into the world failing to see the new responsibilities that we face as a result of this new order.

So, as you go out into your various professions, into your various areas of activity, I would like to suggest to you some of the responsibilities that we face as a result of the emergence of this new order:

FIRST, WE are challenged to rise above the narrow confines of our individualistic concerns to the broader concerns of all humanity.

In this new world, no individual or no nation can live alone. The new world is a world of geographical togetherness — we must make it a world of spiritual togetherness.

Now it is quite true that the geographical togetherness of this new world has been brought into being, largely because of man's scientific ingenuity; man through his scientific genius has been able to dwarf distance and place time in chains.

Yes, he's been able to carve highways through the stratosphere, so that it is possible today to eat breakfast today in New York City and supper in Paris, France.

THERE IS another final challenge:

We're challenged to enter the new age with understanding goodwill in our hearts.

To my mind this is even more important than the other. I'm simply saying that we must enter this new age with the Christian virtues of love, forgiveness and mercy in our hearts.

This is a bit humorous, and I hope I am laughing something basic in all of us. I'm simply saying that we're living in a world today that is geographically one. We must make it spiritually one.

We must learn to live together as brothers or we will all die together as fools.

WE ARE caught and involved in a single process. Whatever affects one directly, it affects all indirectly in this world. We are clothed in a single garment of destiny.

We are caught in an inescapable network of mutuality. So long as hundreds and thousands of people go to bed hungry at night, I can never be rich — even if I have a billion dollars — so long as the life expectancy and millions of people in this world are less than 35 years, I can never be totally healthy.

Thomas Stockett

[Age 82] The longtime illustrator and political cartoonist for the Afro-American newspaper was also a noted portraitist.

THOMAS STOCKETT, WHOSE career as an illustrator and political cartoonist at the *Afro-American* newspaper spanned more than half a century, died Wednesday of a heart attack at Maryland General Hospital. He was 82.

Mr. Stockett, who lived in the Sutton Place Apartments, was en route to work at the *Afro-American's* editorial offices, where he had worked for 53 years, when stricken.

"When he told a story with his artwork, he told it completely, and for the last 50 years, he captured all the important moments," said *Afro* publisher John "Jake" Oliver.

"You could look at one of Tommy's cartoons, and you knew what he was saying. You didn't have to read a 400-word editorial to know what it was about. He made it seem easy," said Mr. Oliver, who described Mr. Stockett as a man with an "international reputation" who was "quiet and painfully bashful."

Through the years, Mr. Stockett's work garnered him many awards from the Maryland-Delaware-D.C. Press Association and the National Newspaper Publishers Association.

"He owned the NNPA," Mr. Oliver said.

"He cared greatly about his work and made sure that his art spoke to whatever the editorial page was proclaiming that week. He was an exacting, calm and a peacefully sweet man," said the Rev. Dorothy S. Boulware, editor of the *Afro-American*. "He told stories and wasn't afraid to go up against the establishment."

Mr. Stockett worked from a cramped office filled with file cabinets containing originals of his work and piles of old newspapers. Colleagues estimated that during his career, he drew more than 7,000 cartoons.

"He worked in pen and ink — no computer — on an old drafting table," Ms. Boulware said.

Mr. Stockett was to be honored next week in Annapolis, where he was to receive Black History Month honors from the state Senate, said Baltimore Sen. Catherine E. Pugh.

"Tuesday's ceremony will still go on," Senator Pugh said yesterday.

"For the last 50 years, he has recorded what has happened to our community and the important moments in the city and state for African-Americans," she said. "His drawings still resonate, and his legacy will live on because of his art."

Senator Pugh added: "His cartoons were not just cartoons. They were messages that asked us to examine our thoughts. They were about social and political issues and asked us to find out what was best for our community."

Mr. Stockett was born and raised in Baltimore. He was diagnosed with polio when he was 2 years old, and doctors gave him only two years to live. His recovery left him partially paralyzed on his right side. Later in life, he lost sight in one eye.

"His right leg and hand never fully developed, and he drew and painted with only his left hand," said C. Allen Board, a Brooklyn artist and longtime friend. "When he was a young boy, his mother would leave a pencil and a piece of paper for him, which was a hint to draw pictures."

Mr. Stockett's interest began when he was 4, and he was painting by the time he was a teenager. He studied at Carver Vocational-Technical High School and later went to work for a Baltimore sign company designing and painting billboards for local movie theaters.

It was his boss at the sign company that helped Mr. Stockett land a job at the *Afro* in 1954.

An *Afro-American* news release announcing his death said Mr. Stockett "consistently poked fun at segregation and showed its inconsistency with American ideals of freedom and democracy." The statement added that he used "his drawings to illustrate an editorial point and help readers envision a particular topic from a black perspective."

"When he did editorial drawings, he did them with ease and made the subject matter come alive. He was thorough, took his time, and was one of the most wonderful cartoonists alive," said Frances L. Murphy, former publisher of the *Washington Afro* and author of the "If You Ask Me" column.

Mr. Stockett was also a talented portraitist who worked in other media, including oils, watercolors and acrylics. He painted all of the portraits that hang in the *Afro's* board room.

Mr. Stockett was well known in the art world and participated in many shows, where his work earned many awards.

"He loved talking to people and showing his art," said Gary Kachadourian, visual arts coordinator for the Baltimore Office of Promotion & the Arts. "It could be the hottest day, and he'd be out there talking to people."

His wife of 40 years, the former Helen Weeden, died in 1988.

Services for Mr. Stockett will be held at noon Monday at the March Funeral Home, 1101 E. North Ave.

Surviving are two sons, Thomas A. Stockett Jr. and David A. Stockett, both of Baltimore; five daughters, Thomasina A. Johnson of Ellicott City, Kathleen E. Jacob and Annette R. Stockett, both of Baltimore, Joanne Waters of Glen Burnie and Linda Savar of Owings Mills; a sister, Pearl L. Mitchell of Baltimore; 13 grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

"His drawings still resonate, and his legacy will live on because of his art," said state Sen. Catherine E. Pugh.
