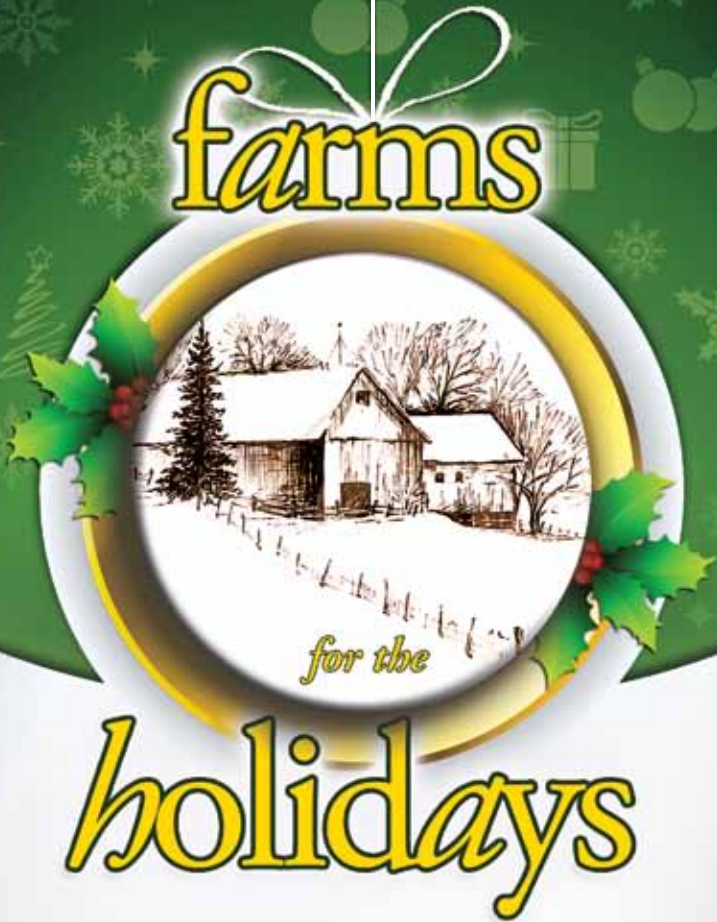

CHRISTMAS TREES AND TRIMMINGS

Basford Creek Tree Farm (SM)

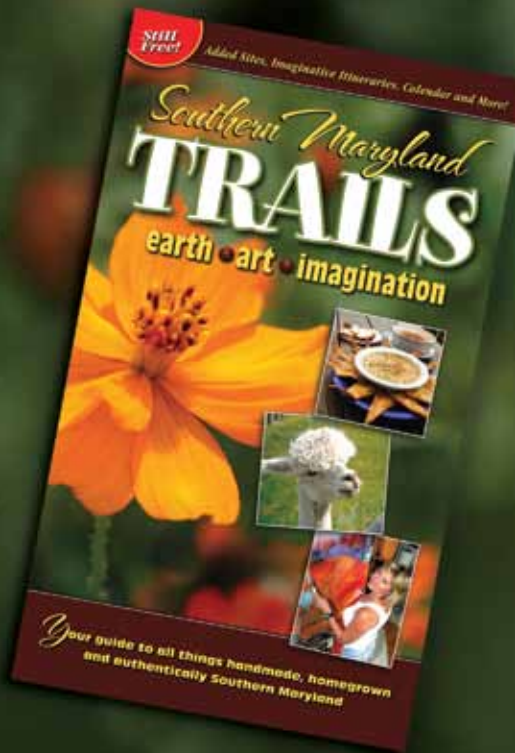

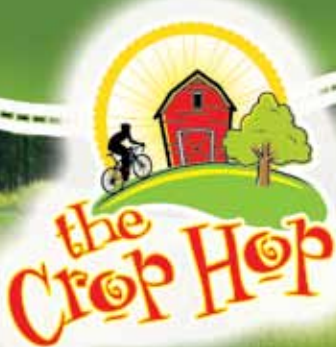
