



Between October 1 and October 10, 2013, Maryland Health Connection had:

- × 217,091 unique website visitors
- 25,781 accounts successfully created with verified identity
- ★ 16,712 eligibility determinations made

Figure 1: Cumulative Total of Accounts Created with Identity Verified






Figure 2: Cumulative Enrollment


Figure 3: Map by Zip Code of First 25,000 Accounts Created in Maryland Health Connection
