MAYOR McLANE BURIED.

Funeral of Baltimore's Dead Mayor Attended by Thousands.

BALTIMORE, June 1.—The funeral of the late Mayor Robert McLane, who shot and killed himself last Monday, took place today. After a brief ceremony at his late home, conducted by Dr. J. B. S. Hodges of Old St. Paul's Protestant Episcopal Church, the body was conveyed to Greenmount Cemetery, where the interment was made.

There were no honorary pall bearers, the members of the family preferring to have a private funeral. The pall bearers included city officials, and college friends of the dead Mayor.

Thousands of friends and admirers of the lamented Mayor lined the sidewalks, with bared heads as the funeral cortège passed on its way to the cemetery.
