Harvey Moses, Plaintiff, by Joseph W. Spector, his Attorney, sues Doctor W. Aubrey Marshall, Defendant.


For that on or about the 18th day of January, 1936, the Defendant was the owner of an automobile which he caused to be operated and driven upon and along certain public highways of the City of Baltimore.

And for that on or about the day and year aforesaid, while the Plaintiff was carefully and prudently driving an automobile north on Etting Street, a certain automobile belonging to the Defendant and operated by himself east on Robert Street was recklessly, negligently and carelessly caused to run into and strike the left rear of the automobile which the Plaintiff was driving.

And for that the Plaintiff was caused to sustain serious and dangerous injuries to his head, body and limbs, suffered great shock, was prevented from pursuing his usual employment, was caused to expend considerable sums of money for doctor bills and medicines, and was otherwise hurt and injured by reason whereof he suffered great physical pain and mental anguish.

And the Plaintiff says that all of his said injuries and damages resulted from the negligence and want of care on the part of the Defendant, and from no fault on the part of the Plaintiff thereunto contributing.

WHEREFORE this suit is brought and the Plaintiff claims Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00) damages.


