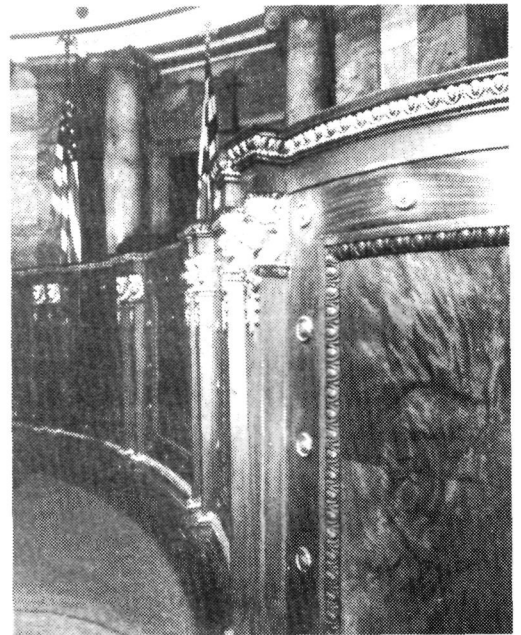

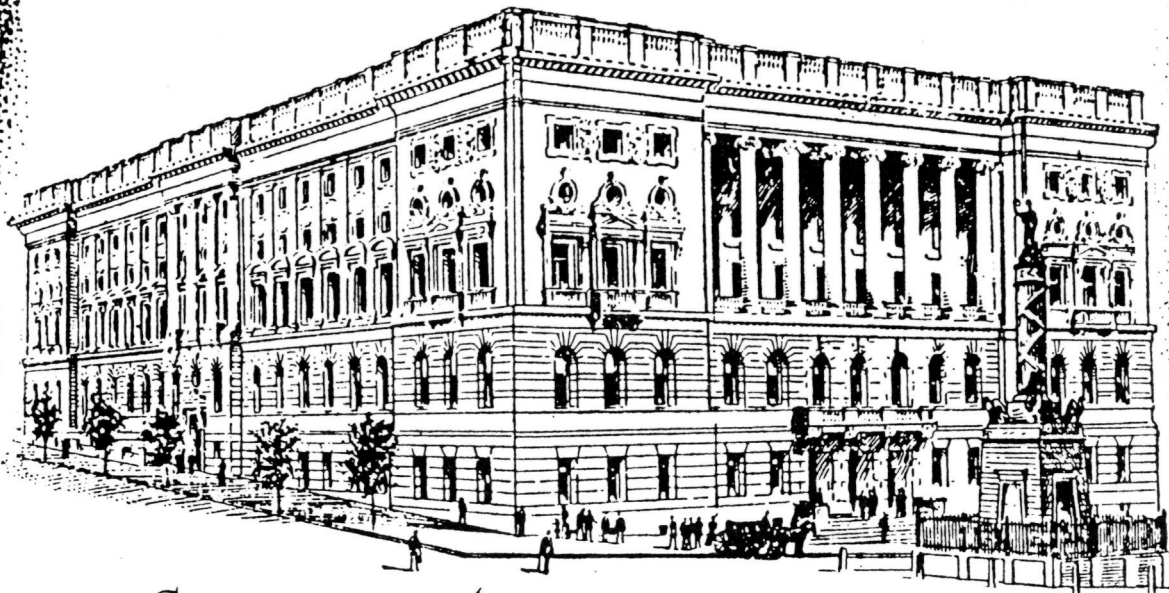

WE'RE RESTORING THE COURTHOUSE

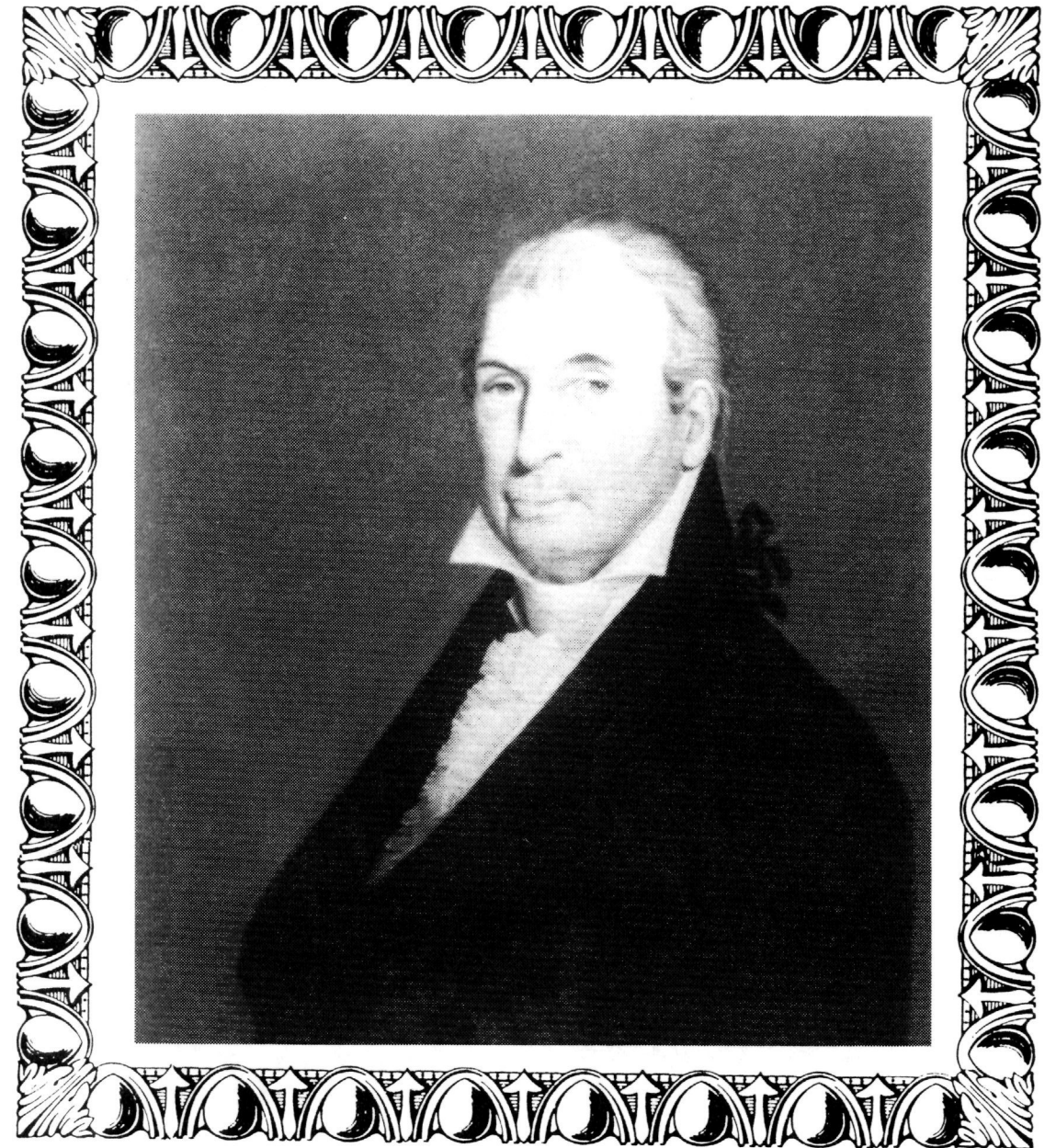
THE BICENTENNIAL BALL IS THE COMMENCEMENT OF A FUNDRAISING CAMPAIGN TO RESTORE THE CLARENCE M. MITCHELL, JR. COURTHOUSE TO ITS ORIGINAL BEAUTY. HISTORIC PORTRAITS, ARCHITECTURAL EMBELLISHMENTS AND PRICELESS ARTISTIC TREASURES ARE SORELY IN NEED OF RESTORATION. THE BALTIMORE COURTHOUSE AND LAW MUSEUM FOUNDATION, INC., A PRIVATE, NON-PROFIT, TAX-EXEMPT CORPORATION HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED TO RAISE REVENUES FOR THIS PURPOSE.

THE BAR ASSOCIATION OF BALTIMORE CITY IS SPEARHEADING THE EFFORT TO BEGIN THE RESTORATION, STARTING WITH COURTROOM 400. THIS IS THE HUGE CEREMONIAL COURTROOM WHICH HAS WITNESSED THE INSTALLATION OF EVERY CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE, THE ADMISSION OF ATTORNEYS TO PRACTICE AND MEMORIAL SERVICES SINCE THE COURTHOUSE OPENED IN 1900. TONIGHT, "THESE AUGUST CHAMBERS" HAVE BEEN CONVERTED INTO A BALLROOM FOR THE CONSTITUTIONAL BICENTENNIAL.

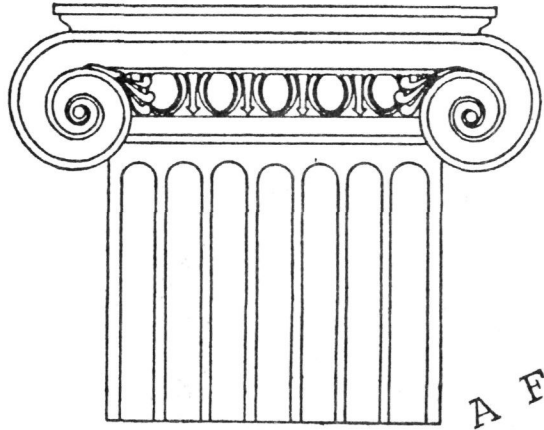

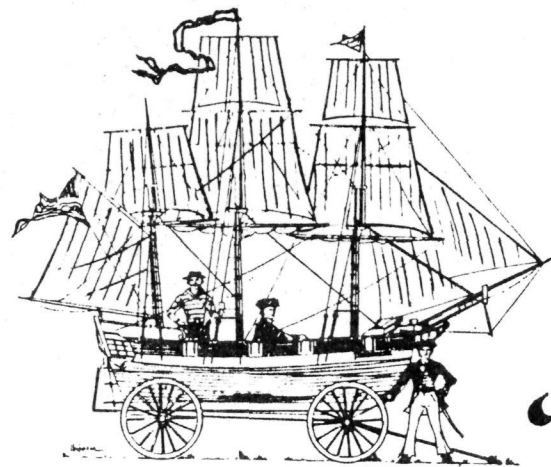

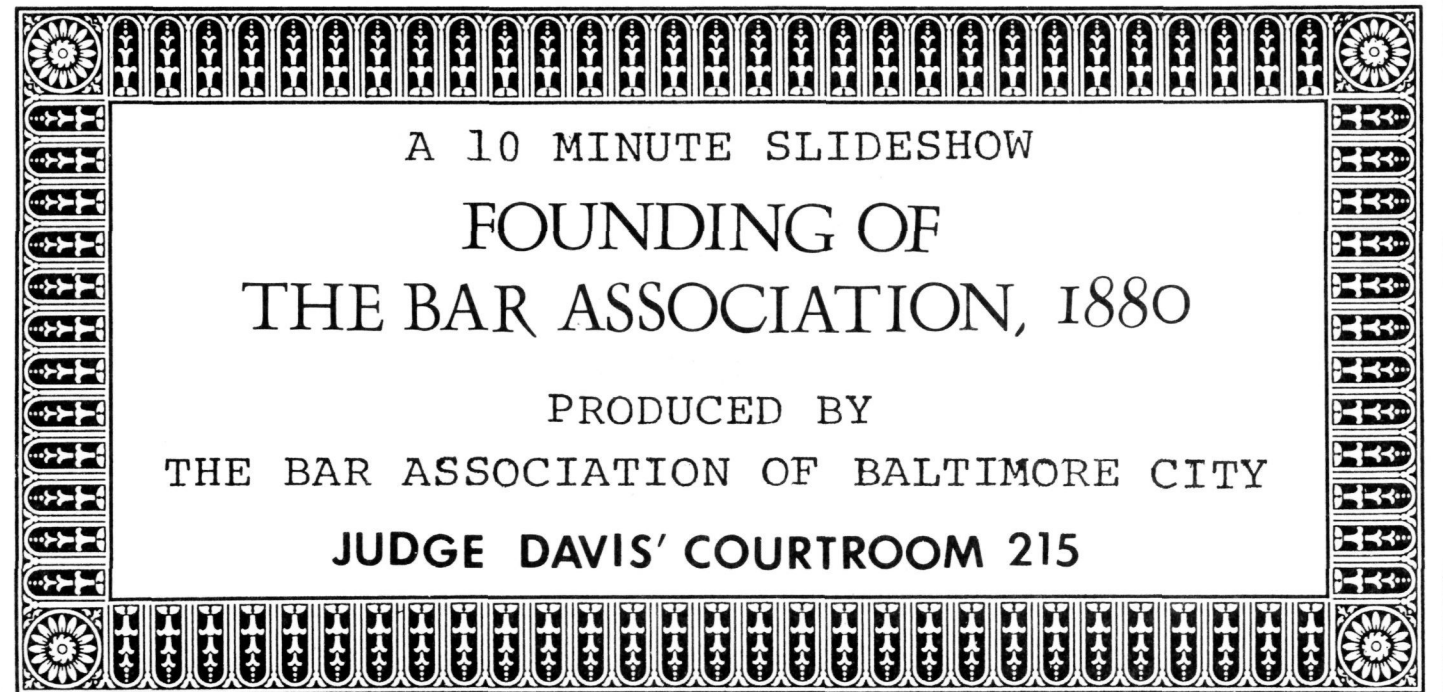
