In the Supreme Bench of Baltimore City:

Whereas it appears to this Court, from an examination of the papers on file in the Circuit Court of Baltimore City in the case of Elizabeth Hamp et al. vs. Katherine M. Miller et al., that a breach of trust has been committed by Edwin R. Davis Esq., a member of the Bar of Baltimore City, acting as receiver in said case under the supervision of the Circuit Court of Baltimore City, in that the said Edwin R. Davis Esq. ^{as such receiver} has collected money to the extent of one hundred and eighty nine $\frac{37}{100}$ dollars, which he has appropriated to his own use.

Therefore it is ordered this 31st day of May 1892, that the said Edwin R. Davis Esq. show cause on or before the 25th day of June 1892, why his name should not be stricken from the roll of attorneys of this Court, provided a copy of this order be served upon him on or before the 4th day of June 1892, and the Clerk of this Court is directed to make said service.

And it is further ordered that the Bar Association of Baltimore City be and it is hereby requested

to act as amicus curiae in
connection with the further pro-
ceedings in this matter, and that
a copy of this request and order
be sent to John J. Donaldson Esq.,
the President of said Association,
